HONORS COURSE REGISTRATION

An Honors Project is designed to allow students the opportunity to conduct advanced research in their chosen discipline. The Honors Project culminates in graduating "with distinction" and special recognition during commencement ceremonies. The project is a four-semester program of individual research directed by a faculty member in the student's academic major and supported by an Honors Project Committee.

In order to be eligible for an Honors Project, a student must meet the following criteria:

1. Have completed sixty (60) hours by the beginning of the first semester of the project,
2. Have completed six (6) hours in their major area, and
3. Maintain an overall GPA of 3.5 with a GPA of 3.75 in the student's major.

Honors courses are applicable ONLY in a student's MAJOR.

Students registering for an honors course must complete the following form, obtaining all necessary signatures, and present it to the Office of the Registrar with the syllabus attached.
