Retirement Fund Choices

GuideStone offers three simple approaches to help you select the right funds for your retirement plan. Each option consists of Christian-screened mutual funds with access to proven investment management firms. As always, we offer our funds with no profit motive and no competing interests. Our bottom line is your bottom line — retirement security.



ONE-CHOICE APPROACH | GuideStone Date Target Funds

A simple retirement strategy, you decide your retirement date and pick the fund with the date closest to your target retirement destination. Date target, or life-cycle, funds are diversified “funds-of-funds” that have an asset allocation that gradually becomes more conservative as you approach and move through retirement. You do not need to remix your funds as you age — your asset allocation will change with you. GuideStone Funds makes available these date target funds — MyDestination Funds® — that are managed to a range of specific target dates in 10-year increments. These funds invest in the GuideStone Select Funds.



ASSET ALLOCATION APPROACH | GuideStone Asset Allocation Funds

Similar to the GuideStone MyDestination Funds, the Asset Allocation Funds are diversified “funds-of-funds.” Unlike the MyDestination Funds, however, you will need to shift your fund allocations if you desire a more conservative approach over time. You simply pick the portfolio mix that meets your particular needs — aggressive, growth, balanced or conservative. These funds invest in the GuideStone Select Funds.



BUILD-YOUR-OWN APPROACH | GuideStone Select Funds

The Select Funds provide a more hands-on approach and allow you to invest in funds with specific styles and objectives. Each Select Fund contains particular types of fixed income or equity investments — for example, short-term bonds or international equities. The majority of the Select Funds use a multi-manager approach by combining different investment management firms — sub-advisors — within a single Select Fund.

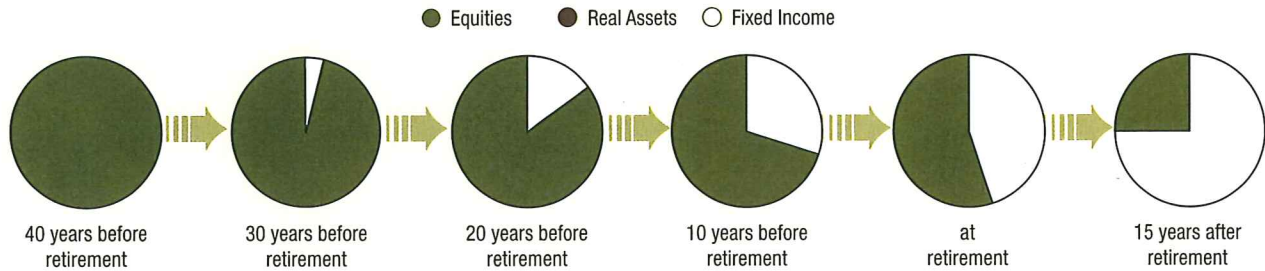
GuideStone Financial Resources Capital Preservation Fund

ONE-CHOICE APPROACH | Date Target Funds

Date Target Funds (MyDestination Funds®) are diversified “funds-of-funds” that have an asset allocation that gradually becomes more conservative as you approach and move through retirement. Below are pie charts that illustrate a dynamic asset allocation that adjusts regularly within a single fund. It is important to note that MyDestination Funds will continue to become more conservative beyond your retirement date. They may be appropriate for investors who plan to retire at an age that is near the target retirement date.



Choosing one is simple. Pick the fund with the date closest to your target retirement destination, and make consistent, appropriate contributions.









The MyDestination Funds ("Funds") attempt to achieve their objectives by investing in the GuideStone Select Funds. The Funds are managed to a retirement date ("target date") by adjusting the percentage of fixed income securities and equity securities to become more conservative each year until reaching the retirement year and then approximately 15 years thereafter. The target date in the name of the Funds is the approximate date when an investor plans to start withdrawing money. By investing in the Funds you will also incur the expenses and risks of the underlying Select Funds. The principal risks of the Funds will change depending on the asset mix of the Select Funds in which they invest. You may directly invest in the Select Funds. The Funds' value will go up and down in response to changes in the share prices of the investments that they own. The amount invested in the Funds is not guaranteed to increase, is not guaranteed against loss, nor is the amount of the original investment guaranteed at the target date. It is possible to lose money by investing in the Funds.

ASSET ALLOCATION APPROACH | Asset Allocation Funds

Like the MyDestination Funds, each Asset Allocation Fund is a “fund-of-funds” investment portfolio that is pre-mixed and diversified. Unlike the MyDestination Funds, these funds do not consider your time horizon, and investors should re-evaluate their allocations as they draw closer to retirement.

The longer you have until retirement the more you may benefit from an allocation that offers a higher risk/reward ratio, such as the Growth Allocation and Aggressive Allocation Funds. However, if you’re closer to retirement, you may want to consider more conservative options like the Conservative Allocation or possibly the Balanced Allocation Fund.

Choose the fund that best fits your needs. This approach allows you to select the asset allocation most appropriate for you. View the charts below for the asset allocation of each fund.






The fund seeks to maximize current income while seeking to maintain a stable value per share.

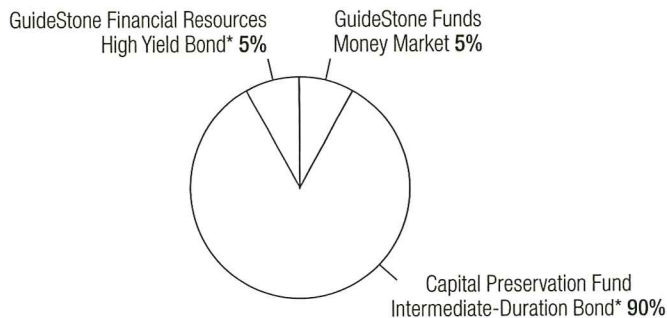
Investment Strategy
