

Qualifications

- Actively engaged in and committed to your faith in Jesus Christ
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 hours (unless last semester) and a maximum of 18 hours, unless otherwise approved by the Director of Residence Life
- Must have completed 24 hours by term of employment
- Must have lived on campus at least one full semester
- Must commit to a full academic year. (Dates of employment: August 1, 2019 through May 10, 2020)

Personal Expectations

- Continually seeking to build your faith in Jesus Christ and lead a Christ-centered lifestyle.
- Must view the Resident Assistant position as your primary servant-leadership role on/off campus.
- Overnights away from campus: you will be allotted 10 overnights away from campus each semester.
- Must be willing to live in the hall and on the floor assigned to you by the Residence Life staff.
- The use of tobacco and alcohol while serving as an RA is not permitted, whether you are of age or not.
- It is important for RAs to remember that their position is demanding and thus their other activities will have to be limited. No student teaching or interning should occur during the fall semester. (Those involved in student teaching, nursing clinicals, internships, and athletics need to prayfully and thoughtfully consider the time commitment for each and be prepared to discuss the situation in the interview.)
- Be back on campus for RA Training two weeks prior to the start of classes in the fall semester and one week prior to the start of classes in the spring semester.
